The raw data contained in CCR results has a column titled 'Time Zone Code'. The 'Call Type' of SMS on the CCR results have a 'Time Zone Code' as 'STD'.

Vodafone CCR Data:

The carrier explanation interpretation for the Time Zone Code 'STD' is as follows:

Time Zone Code *Indicates which time zone to attribute to the event and the local start time column.*

Where a State is shown e.g., NSW, QLD, NT, SA, TAS, VIC, WA, the time is local to that state.

Where STD is shown = Standard Network Time which is always equivalent to Eastern Standard Time (note - never Daylight Saving Time)
