MS CATHCART: Could the witness be shown page 496 of the brief. Mr Abdi, is this a third invoice to Downer from JTG Services in relation to the same project for \$97,160?---Yes, that's right.

40 So the three to four days' work, you're paid invoices of 86,000, \$97,160 and \$41,000. Is that right?---Yes, that's right.

Mr Abdi, in fairness to you, we have a lot of documents in relation to this investigation. We've spoken to a lot of people. We'll be able to verify whether or not you were in the vicinity of Katoomba on weekends. Did you actually undertake this work?---Yeah, so, so like I said, the, the, the, the, they got a quote for 700 and it was, it was, it was more, it had to be done actually secretively and, and under wraps because if it was identified, it would have implicated Downer into millions of dollars of commercial dispute with the client.

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THE COMMISSIONER: How did you know that?---'Cause Abdul told me.

MS CATHCART: So these aren't just false payments that Abdul has been able to approve to JTG Services?---No. No.

The work was actually undertaken by JTG?---Yeah.
