for adopting the Committee's charter, in accordance with guidelines from the

6. In my opinion, the functioning/operation of the Committee is primarily the

responsibility of the chair, having regard to the provisions of the charter. If the

Committee was not functioning or operating in accordance with the charter or

was unable to carry out its functions because of a lack of information, then in

my opinion the chair would have a responsibility to draw this to the attention of

meeting in the absence of any management, including the General Manager. The

Committee is required to meet at least once a year with the Internal Auditor in the

absence of management.

The Committee may meet with the External Auditor at any time in the absence of

management if it determines that it is appropriate to do so. The Committee is
