RID Squad Coordinator's Report November 2014 – January 2015

During this period of time some staff had annual leave for short periods and investigators prioritised jobs to ensure that urgent issues were addressed and council/customer enquiries were actioned.

Some signage (new Re-branding) has been installed (photograph below depicts signage installed by Holroyd Council), and investigators are placing corf lute signs in appropriate locations.

Blacktown City Council has formally requested to Joining the Western Sydney Regional Illegal Dumping Squad and this item has been placed on the agenda for discussion.

Several jobs remain outstanding with investigations continuing and it is anticipated that and a number of PINS will be issued in the coming months.







Operational Statistics (Summary)

- 1277 Illegal dumping incidents were investigated
- 237 Investigations not yet finalised



OPERATIONS

De-Brief - The Hills LGA Operation - 18th December 2014

BACKGROUND:

On Thursday 18th December 2014 five (5) Officers' from the Regional Illegal Dumping Squad conducted an operation in The Hills LGA.

This operation was titled follow 'Follow that Truck.

The operation focused on the activities by Demolition and Earthworks transporters in relation to illegal land fill and focus given to the rural areas within the Council's in relation to unlawful illegal dumping.

CURRENT POSITION:

As a result of this operation a total of twenty three (23) heavy vehicles were followed with all vehicles being tracked out of area or to authorized sites to accept the material.

Location one (1) – 10 Cranstons Rd Middle Dural



Officers followed a truck to the aforementioned property. Both the driver and property owner were spoken to and it was revealed that consent had been sought from Council to bring in a small amount of clean fill.

Location two (2) – 1455 Old Northern Rd Glenorie – (Hornsby LGA)

Trucks were identified leaving a source site in Sylvan Street Galston and transported demolition waste to No 1455 Old Northern Rd Glenorie. Hornsby Council was contacted and responded to matter promptly.




