Afternoon All

News of this last week has highlighted the extraordinary power and destructive forces associated with storm and flood events. As we watch, read and listen to reports from those so terribly affected, our hearts go out to those that have lost loved ones, have family and friends unaccounted for and that have months and years, if not a lifetime of rebuilding their homes, businesses and local communities.

As you would expect, I have been speaking with interstate colleagues this week and have extended our condolences and offered the support of the RFS in any way considered necessary. The assistance sought to date has largely centred on the provision of aircraft by the RFS, USAR & Swift Water Rescue teams from NSWFB and some assistance from SES. The focus of assistance to date has been in the rescue and recovery of trapped and isolated people as well as those that remain unaccounted for.

Yesterday I spoke with one of our members, Captain Kendall Thompson of the Kootingal Brigade near Tamworth. Kendall was deployed with one of our aircraft into some of the worst affected areas across the border. Kendall, who has qualifications in aviation and RAFT, was deployed as the 'down the wire crewman' (basically operating at the end of the winch line). In what can only be described as atrocious conditions, Kendall was personally responsible for the rescue of 40 - 50 people stranded and trapped in flood waters. Soaked through to the bone, due to torrential rain and wading through water up to neck deep at times, he was repeatedly inserted into the water, onto roof tops, floating cars, etc. Left to prepare and secure the victims, he would then call the aircraft in and either winch or hover load people into the helicopter for transport to safer ground. He has described the experience as something he'd certainly never seen before and was simply not prepared for the enormity or scale of destruction and devastation. His efforts were nothing short of extraordinary and he says that he and the team simply did what they could and whilst they couldn't save everyone, they rescued as many as was physically possible. Kendall has done a number of interviews since returning home for radio, television and print media.

I appreciate the level of interest amongst members to assist colleagues in QLD however following conversations with interstate colleagues as late as yesterday evening it is unlikely that we will be called on for any additional assistance at this stage. Obviously such planning and decisions are made depending on circumstances and should there be any change, they are well aware of our open offer of assistance.

While the majority of the media focus this week has centred on devastation in south east Queensland, and quite rightly so, we need to remember that communities right across much of QLD and Northern NSW have been affected by storm, rain and flood events since well before Christmas.

The RFS continues to provide assistance to SES right across northern NSW. This week we have liaison officers in the State Emergency Operations Centre (SEOC), State Public Information and Inquiries Centre (PIIC), SES Richmond Tweed and Clarence Nambucca Regional HQs. Districts and brigades continue to assist SES from Far North Coast, Northern Rivers, Clarence Valley, Northern Tablelands, Mid North Coast, Lower North Coast and Namoi Gwydir. The State Air Desk has deployed up to 17 aircraft a day across northern NSW and QLD.

I would like to extend my appreciation to all members across the Service for their continued assistance to SES and local communities across NSW and for the significant level of interest in offering support to our colleagues and communities so tragically affected in Queensland. Queensland authorities are well aware of the offer of assistance

and will not hesitate to seek our support if considered necessary. Our Minister and Premier have spoken with their counterparts and extended the offer of any assistance at the highest of levels.

With La-Nina remaining strong and catchments well saturated, particularly in northern areas, concerns still remain for the impacts of any future storm and rain events. I would encourage members to monitor daily situation reports regarding flooding in NSW on the SES website at www.ses.nsw.gov.au.

Further to my note of Friday and with the flood crisis continuing across large parts of the country, the NSW RFS is now providing assistance across three states.

On Saturday, I received a formal request from authorities in Queensland for assistance with the flood recovery across Brisbane and the state's south-east.

We now have two strike teams and support personnel working in Brisbane. The strike teams comprise five tankers each, helping to hose out flood affected homes and businesses in areas such as Fairfield and Milton. From all accounts, since they arrived in Brisbane, our crews have been hard at work and there remains much more to be done. This is in addition to the aviation resources committed last week, assisting with flood rescues across the Lockyer Valley.

In Victoria, we have had a number of crews working in areas such as Echuca which have experienced record flood levels. Our crews, deployed from the Mid Murray Zone, have been assisting with sandbagging in the township and our commitment there remains ongoing.

Here in NSW, our commitment also remains ongoing. Over the weekend, we have had members assisting the SES with flood operations across the north coast and in areas such as Boggabilla which have also experienced severe flooding.

Something that is often spoken about in relation to the RFS is our versatility and once again, the work we are engaged in across NSW, Queensland and Victoria has demonstrated the professionalism and willingness of our people to help in times of need.

I have been encouraged by the number of people expressing interest in deployments to flood affected areas. The deployment of resources is being made based on requests when they are received. It is important that these are coordinated to ensure the appropriate resources are deployed to the areas that need them and to ensure that any personnel we deploy are appropriately managed in areas such as welfare, logistics and operations.

I think we have all been affected by the dramatic coverage and tragic stories coming from flood affected areas - particularly in Queensland. At the same time, the resilience of those so terribly affected and the scenes of many thousands of people putting up their hands to assist people in need has been nothing short of inspirational and is testament to that great Aussie spirit of mate helping mate. Obviously, if you are in a position to assist financially, I would encourage you to donate to the Queensland Premier's Flood Appeal at www.qld.gov.au.

The NSW RFS stands ready to provide any further assistance to those affected and we will continue to liaise with relevant authorities on requirements for any additional resources required.

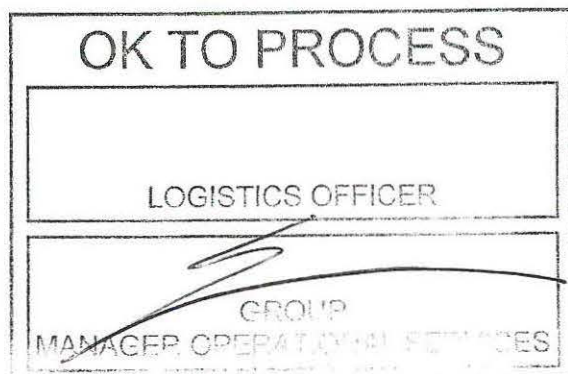

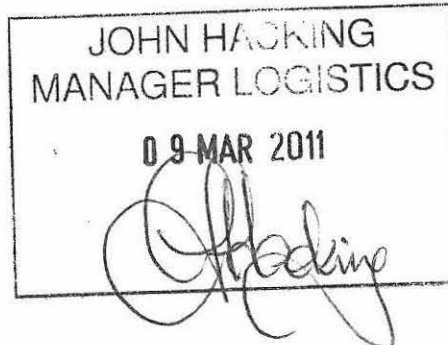
