Hi Joe,

I have reviewed the EI contract with RailCorp. We are contracted until 30 September 2012 on the "special" Project Director rate of \$1,949 per day. Thereafter, RailCorp has the sole rights to continue to use EI under the same terms and conditions except that the daily rate reverts to the Schedule of Rates for the Project Director. This was set at \$2,300 per day, plus a 5% increase which applied to all rates in the Schedule of Rates from 1 January 2011 – ie. \$2,415 per day.

It therefore seems the mechanism legitimately exists to extend EI's services beyond September 2012.
