Selection Criteria	Weighting of selection criteria in relation to each other
The position requires contemporary and extensive knowledge, skills and experience of technical surveillance work, including:	
Knowledge of technical surveillance methodologies demonstrated by substantial current experience within a law enforcement environment. Proficient in the use of equipment, including: digital radio networks; A/V monitoring, capture, transmission and storage devices; data monitoring devices; telecommunications interception; IT systems and networking; and covert method of entry techniques.	40%
Demonstrated knowledge of Commonwealth and State legislation relevant to the exercise of technical surveillance activities, and investigative methodologies, legal requirements and evidentiary standards for investigations into serious offences or public sector misconduct.	20%
Well-developed decision making and prioritisation skills, problem solving and analytical skills.	20%
Ability to work well in a team, communicate effectively with people of diverse background, occupation, and seniority, both internal and external to the Commission.	20%
