

 2. My name is Andrew (Andy) George Sammut. I am 59 years old. I was previously employed by Canterbury City Council from March 25 1985 to 26 September 2016.
 3. Between 2015 and 2016, I was employed as the Director of Corporate Services with responsibility for directing 11line managers delivering a broad range of Corporate and Community Programs including Finance, HR, Governance, Customer Services, IT, Property Services, Corporate Planning, Community Development, Libraries, Child Care and Aquatic Centres.
 4. As part of this responsibility I attended meetings of the Executive that included the General Manager, the Director of City Works, the Director of Planning and myself.

I recall on one occasion, as best as I can remember, where Mr Montague said in my company something along the lines of “Whatever these guys want, you give them” to those in attendance – that included one person representing City Works. 8. I am uncertain when exactly this occurred, but my memory was that it was in an Executive meeting in the conference room where they were usually held.
9. I’m also not sure if the comment was just regarding Crs Azzi and Hawatt but was to include other Councillors in the group that were then controlling Council.
