We are instructed by our client, Mr Spiro Stavis, to make the following disclosure to the ICAC.

- At around 10.45am today (19 April 2018), Mr Stavis was at work and received a call from reception that there was a “Bechara Vangali” waiting to see him at reception.
- Mr Stavis told his receptionist that he did not know such a man and that he had no record of any appointment.
- Whilst Mr Stavis was still on the line, the receptionist queried the man who indicated that he had some plans for Mr Stavis to review.
- Mr Stavis went to reception and recognised Bechara Khouri waiting in reception for him.
- Mr Stavis asked Mr Khouri what he wanted. Mr Khouri said that he had some plans for Mr Stavis to review. Mr Stavis replied that he could not assist and said goodbye to Mr Khouri.
- There was no further interaction. The exchange lasted less than 2 minutes.
