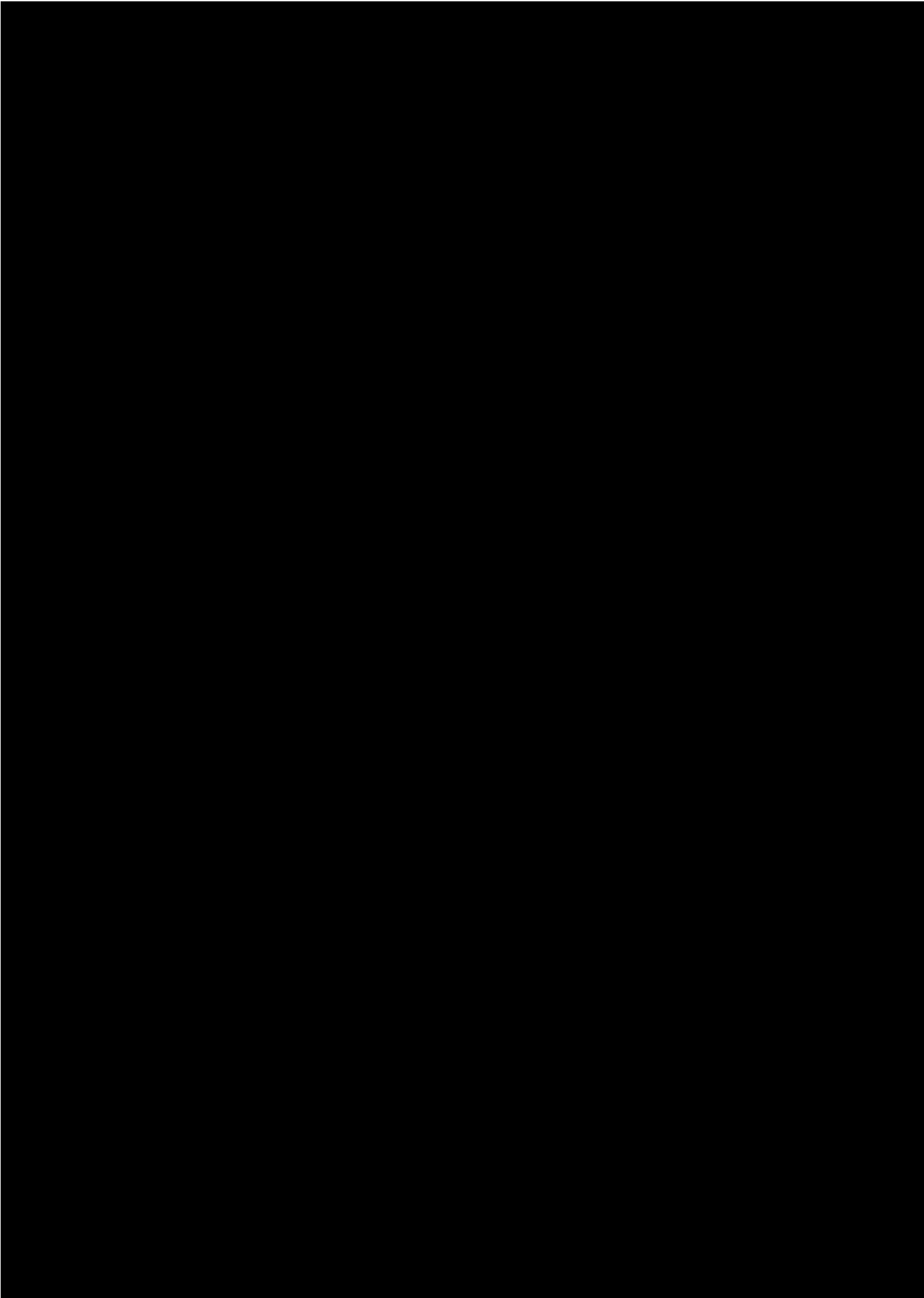

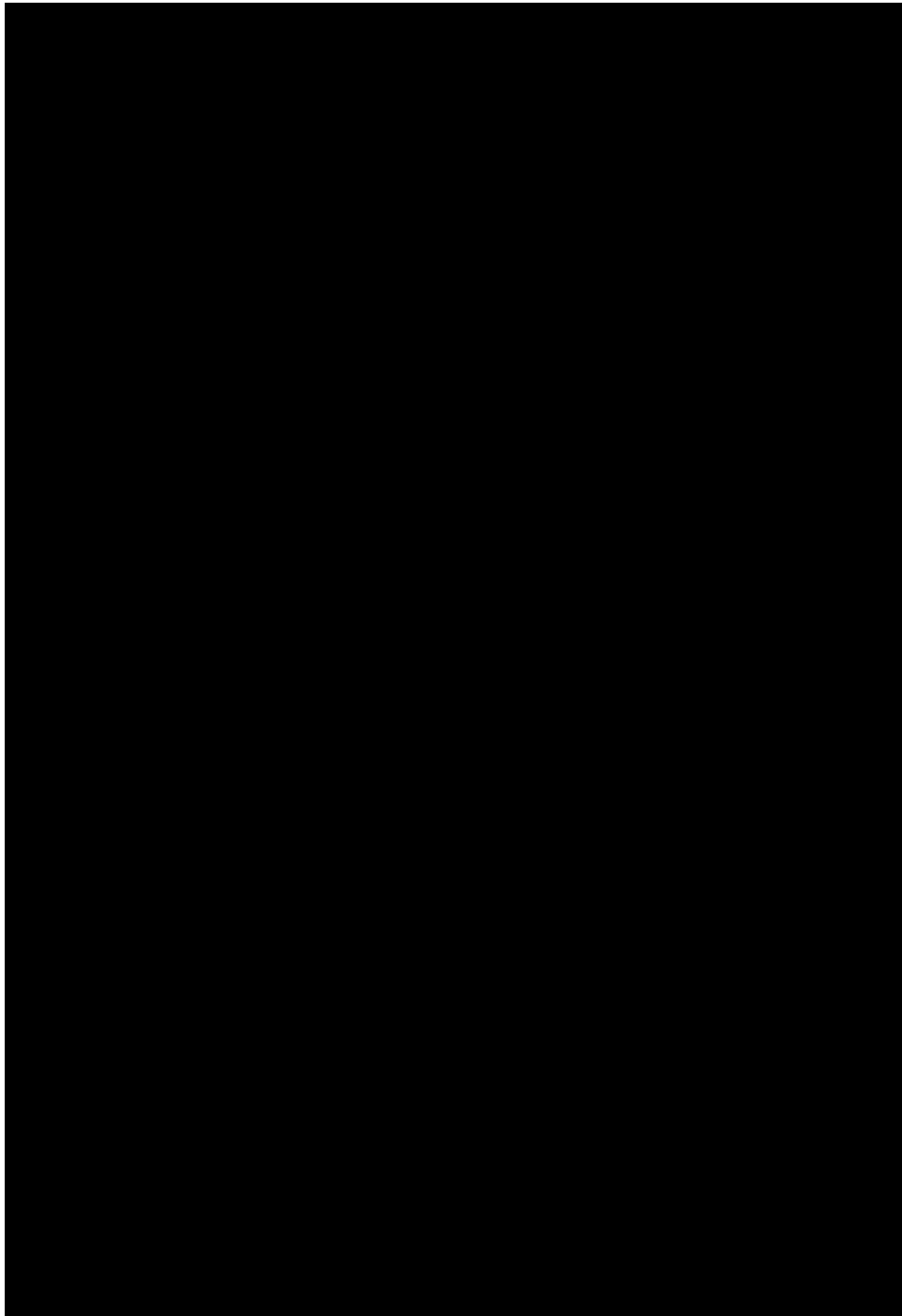

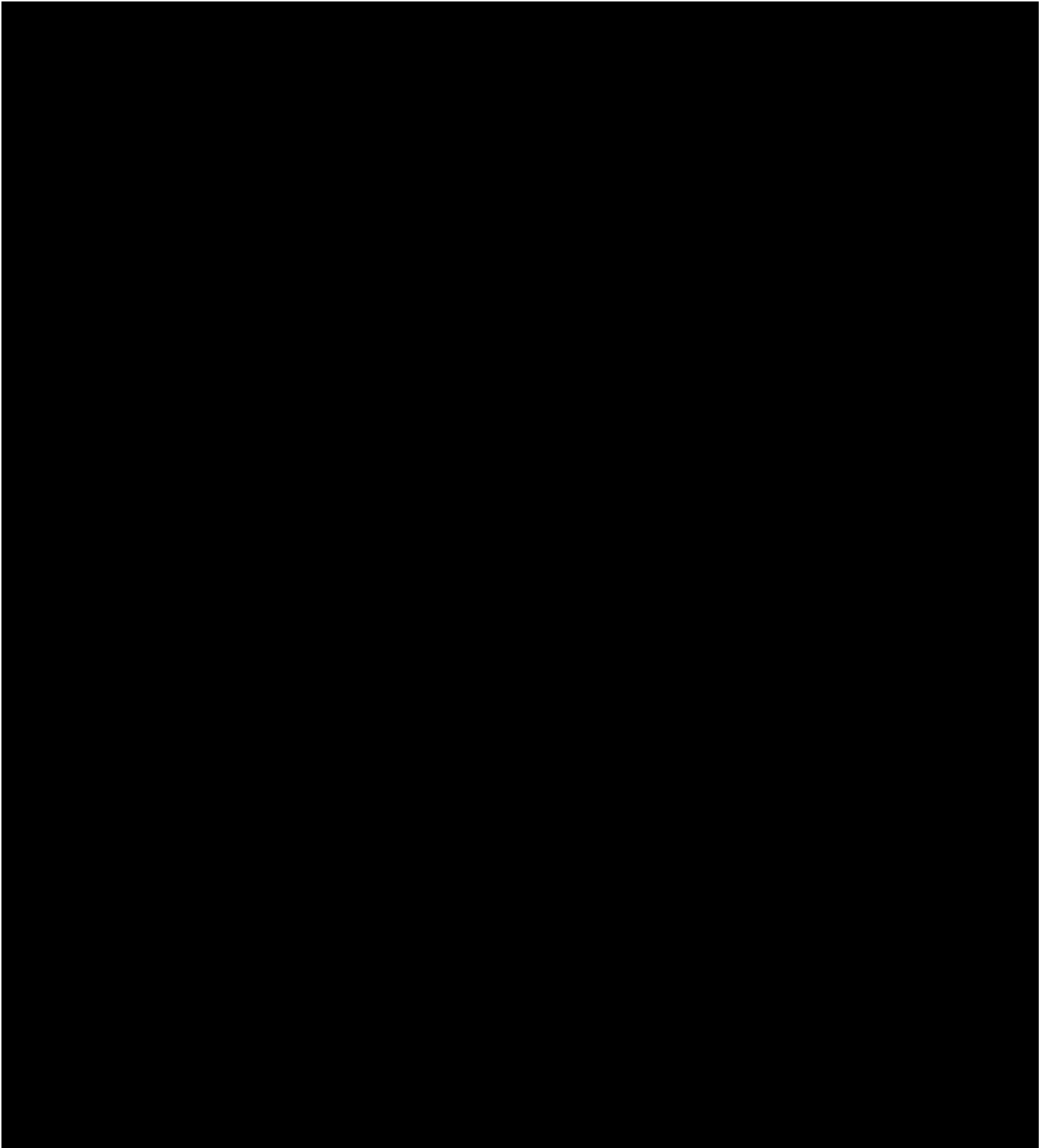

Sir,

I wish to bring to your attention the following shortfalls in camera coverage. Whilst this is not a comprehensive list, I believe that these points affect the safety and security of the centre.

1. With the installation of the fences for the clinic yards, camera coverage of both the new Methadone window and yard is very limited. The camera views are either obscured by the covered walkway, or the multiple layers of fence.
2. There is no camera coverage for 2 unit yards at all.
3. The camera view of 3.1 yard is restricted by the recently installed shelter roofs. It is not possible to view the step and external phone, or the toilet areas of the yard.
4. There are no cameras covering the gym/BBQ areas of both 5.1 and 5.2. The officer observation of these areas is severely restricted.
5. The new building being constructed behind industries will obscure all views of the rear gate area of industries.
6. Currently, video coverage of the top unit gates and races is from cameras on opposite sides of the compound. The construction of a building in the centre of the compound will obscure these views, and thus have little or no vision of top compound and gates.

Today Wednesday 19th February 2014 the centre was attended by SOG to assist the local IAT with target searches of cell/inmates at Lithgow Correctional Centre. During the searching numerous inmates were questioned in regards to drug and weapon possession at the centre. During the informal interviews an informant stated that there was a large quantity of suboxone in a cell occupied by [REDACTED] cell# 208 5.1.1 unit. The informant was confident in the information, and has previously been reliable. This is consistent with the current drug of choice at Lithgow CC. The Manager of Security was informed and instructed to have this information forwarded to the search teams and have [REDACTED] included in the target searches.

Subject: Minor Use of Force inmate [REDACTED]

Sir During the course of the search operation today at Lithgow cc I attended cell #208 in 5 unit MPU occupied by inmate [REDACTED] as information from another inmate during searches in 3 unit had implicated [REDACTED] as having a large amount of tablets of buprenorphine.

As I entered the cell the inmate now known to me as [REDACTED] jumped up from the lower bunk where he was seated and appeared to throw an item towards the toilet at the rear of the cell as I attempted to retrieve the item [REDACTED] moved between me and the toilet impeding my path to the toilet [REDACTED] moved towards the toilet and as he reached to flush the toilet [REDACTED] tripped on the plastic chair and his torso landed on the rim of the cell toilet and landed on the cell floor.

[REDACTED] was placed in restraints the inmate and removed him from the cell and placed him in an empty cell as [REDACTED] was searched.

The inmate was compliant during the move and apologised for his actions.

Background:

Information was received from Family and Community Services (FACS) New South Wales (NSW) detailing information regarding inmates allegedly misusing the FACS Housing NSW contact number on the Offender Telephone System (OTS). IR-14-0227 and IR-13-1819 relate.

Information:

The information received appears to be an extract from the FACS NSW intranet website and states:

"FACS Housing NSW staff have been receiving phone calls from Corrective Services NSW Inmates. Inmates have been calling FACS Housing NSW on 1300 268 746. They claim to be a tenant and ask to be put through to a nominated local office. Inmates then ask to speak to their Client Service Officer, Vanessa for example. When our FACS Housing NSW staff member says there is no Vanessa at that office, the Inmate says she must be from another office and asks the staff member to put the Inmate through to Vanessa on her mobile number. The Inmate has that number ready to provide. The number then connects with a friend or family.

We get these calls because this FACS Housing NSW number is listed by Corrective Services as one of the numbers that any Inmate can call without restriction (as is the case with Centrelink and other agencies). By calling FACS Housing NSW, Inmates can bypass the standard Corrective Services systems to contact who the Inmate chooses. FACS Housing NSW could potentially be used to facilitate access by Inmates to persons who they are not permitted to engage with (such as victims and associates).

If you receive one of these phone calls do not transfer the Inmate through to the mobile number they provide. Simply advise the person that they will need to call the number themselves and terminate the call. Currently Corrective Services are moving to stop this practice but this may take some time....'

As indicated in the information above, FACS NSW staff have been instructed to cease the practice of forwarding callers to nominated numbers.

This report is provided for information purposes only to indicate inmate actions that may be occurring across CSNSW, and the steps being taken by FACS Housing to prevent this practice.

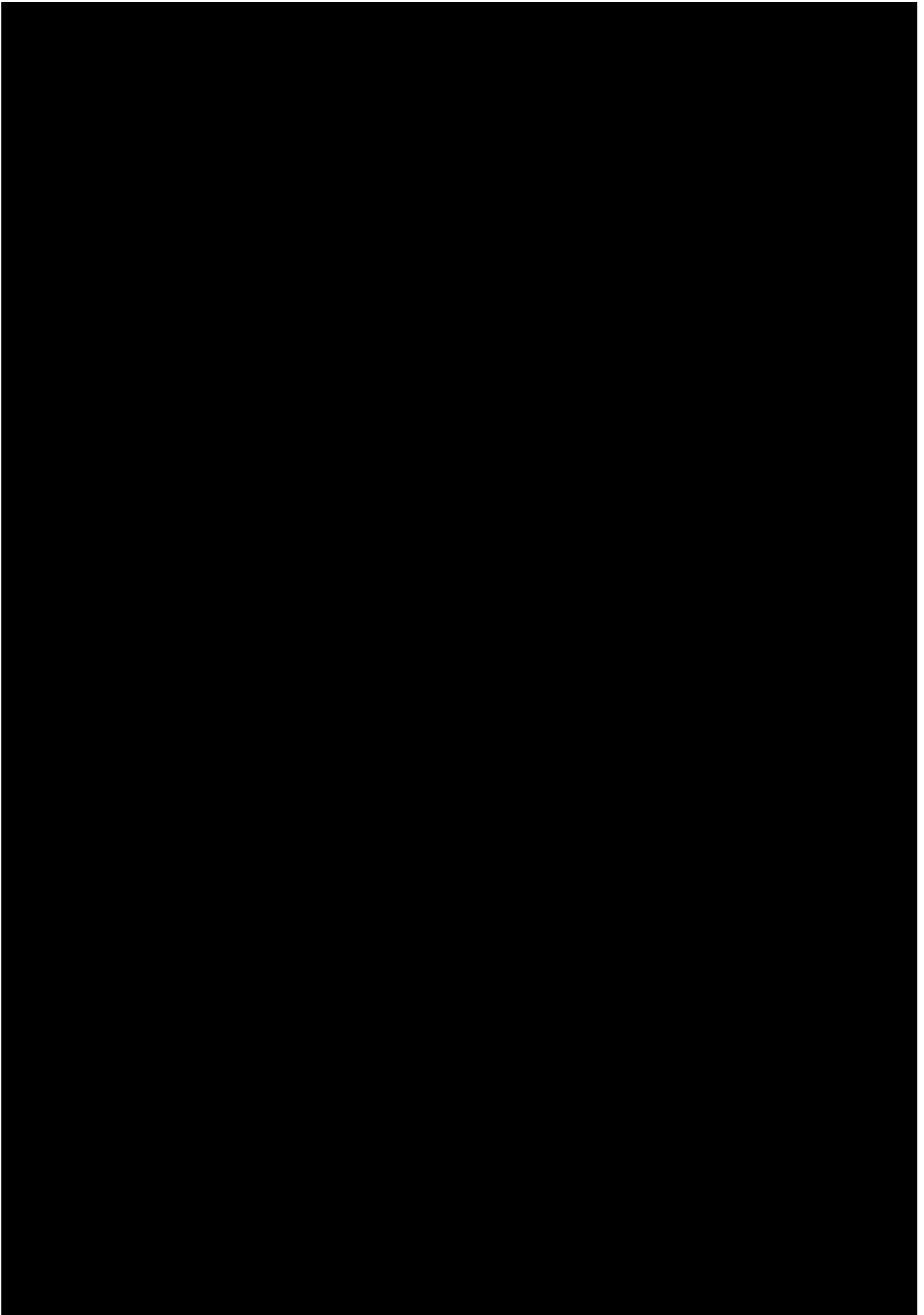

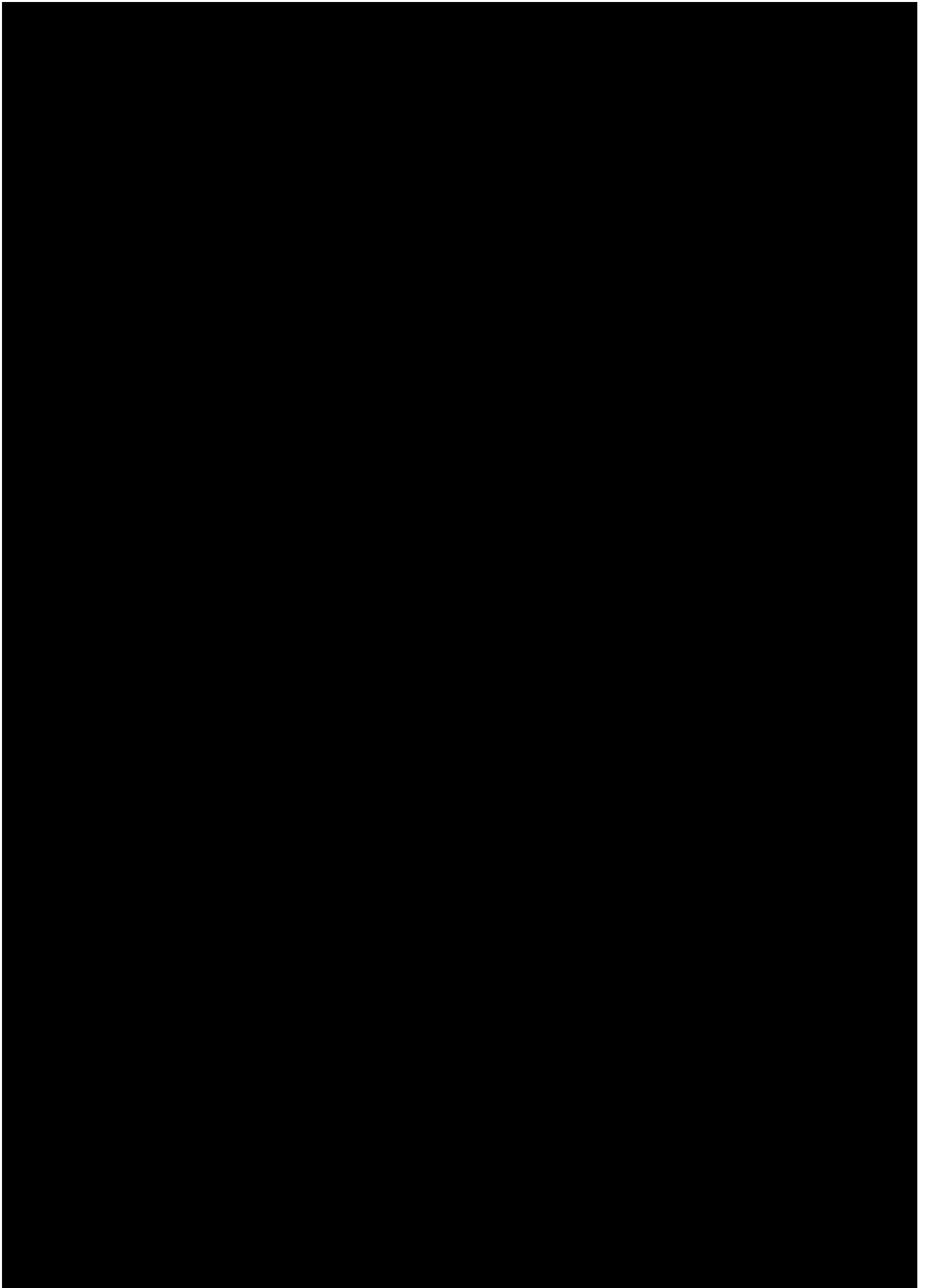

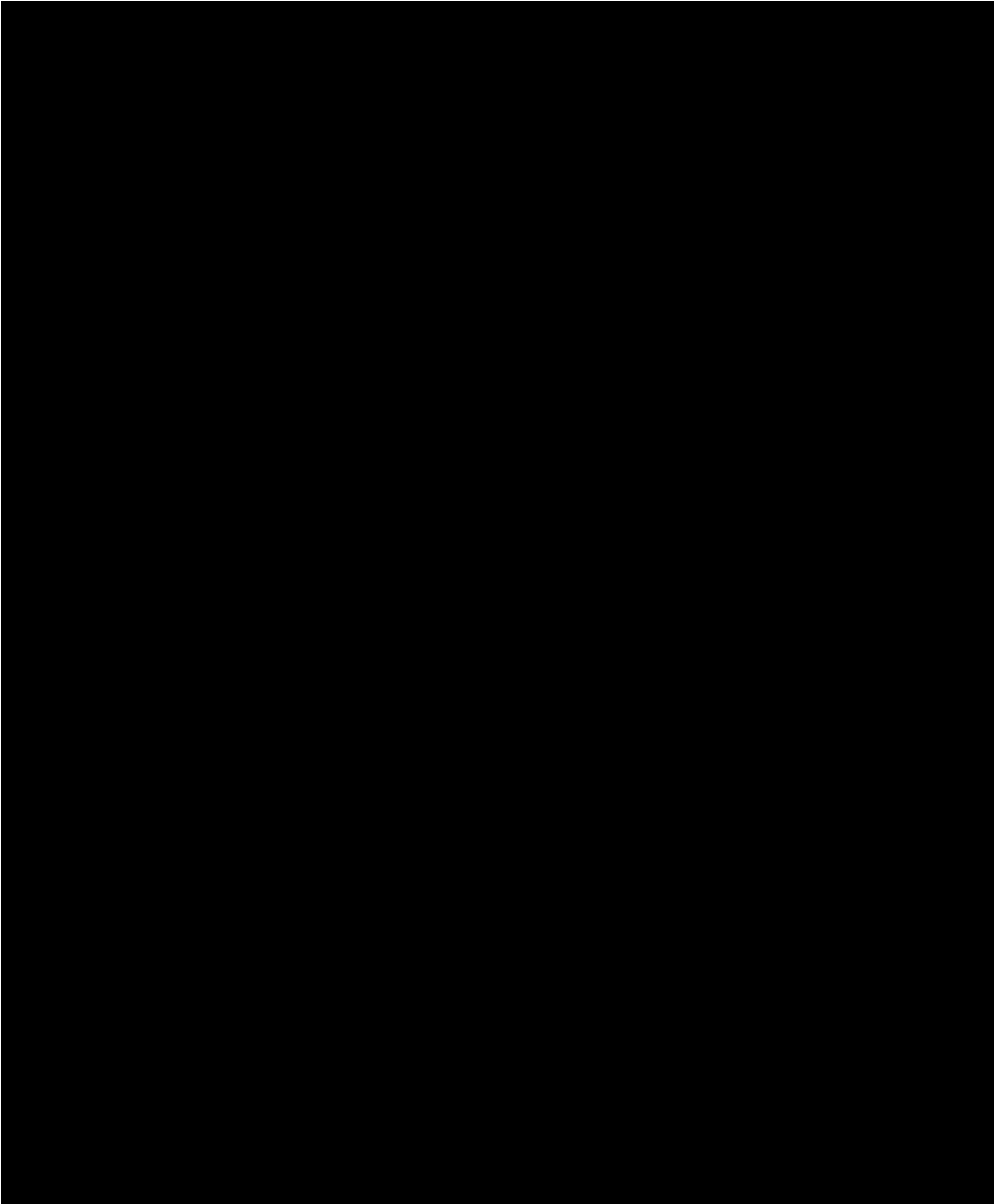
