

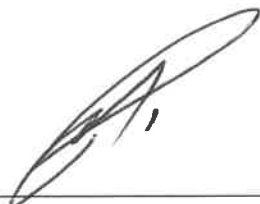

 - A sealed box containing electronic equipment

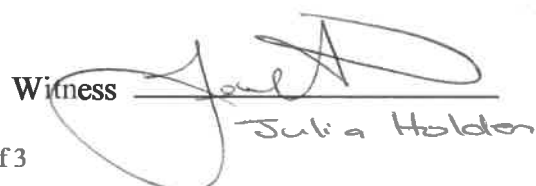
Mr Everson was present during this time.

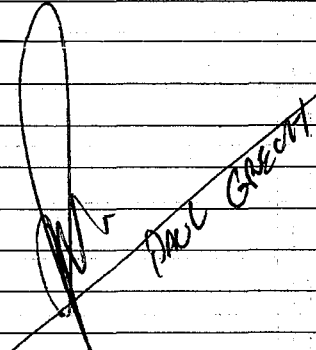
