Oversight and Compliance

- The Clerk of the Scottish Parliament is responsible for monitoring compliance with the Act, and has the power to require information from registrants (see section 21), or unregistered persons - if they reasonably believe they may be engaged in regulated lobbying.
- Failure to register, or provide inaccurate information returns, or failure to comply with an investigation will incur fines. For example, failure to register is a criminal offence, for the organisation as well as its directors, officers and managers.
- The Commissioner for Ethical Standards in Public Life in Scotland has a duty to investigate and report on complaints about compliance with the Act. The Commissioner can require the production of documents or call witnesses to give evidence, and report to Parliament on the findings (sections 22-38 of the Act refer to powers and duties).
