



JIANGXI VISIT PROMOTES CHINA LINKS



A delegation from China's Jiangxi Province has visited Melbourne to explore trade and industry links with Victoria.

President of the Legislative Council Bruce Atkinson and Speaker of the Legislative Assembly Telmo Languiller welcomed the delegation to Parliament House.

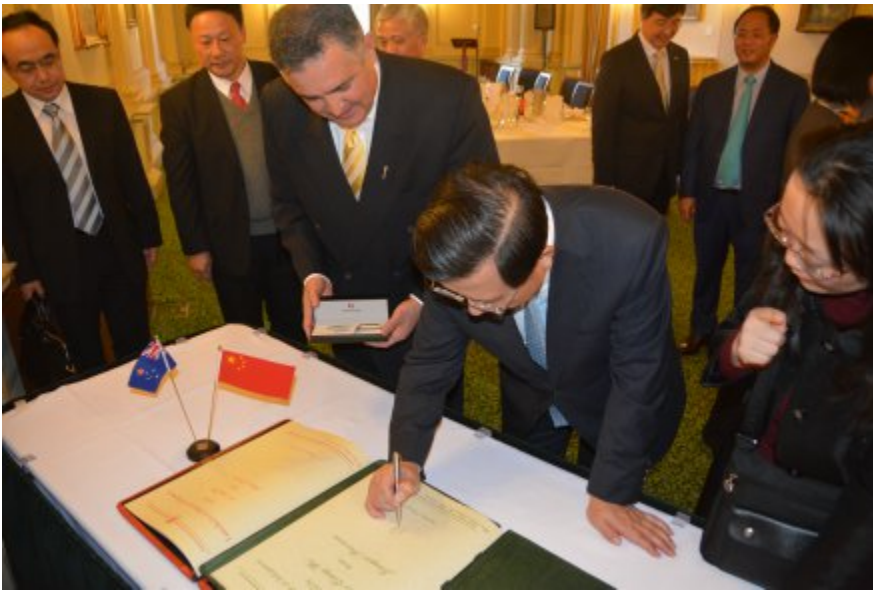


The Victorian Parliament's Presiding Officers welcomed Mr Qiang Wei and his delegation to Parliament House
