Li lines up to fight for West Ward

Independent Ryde councillor Justin Li has announced the full line-up of his team contesting West Ward in the September 8 Council election.

"We are a group of non-party aligned ordinary residents with diverse experiences and backgrounds who care very much about the future of this community," he said.

Mr Li is a well known local lawyer and believes that his service on Council is his way of giving something back to the community.

"When mum and dad settled in Eastwood as migrants 23 years ago, they didn't imagine I'd be taking this role on Council one day," he said.

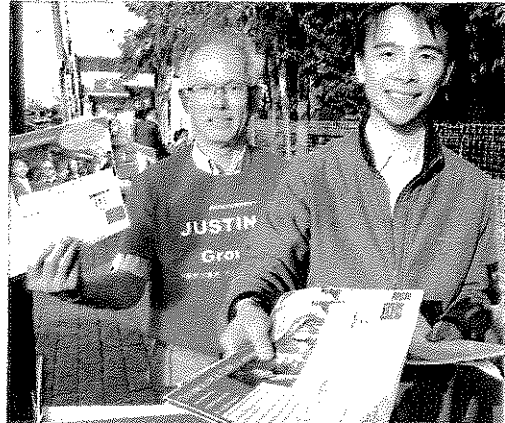
He listed the team's key priorities.

"The team's key priorities for Ryde include connecting the Ryde community through free Wi-Fi in public domains in Eastwood and West Ryde, keeping council rate increases low, supporting free parking, and improving public facilities and services, including preserving and expanding the Top Ryder bus service.

"In the last four years, I have consistently voted to save the free Top Ryder bus service from those councillors who wanted to scrap the service as a cost-cutting measure," he said.

"I'm pleased to see the service is now financially sustainable and I will be looking for opportunities to expand the service to Marsfield and Macquarie Park."

Mr Li is a vehement opponent of parking meters and

counts as one of his major achievements with the removal of the Marsfield parking meters during this term of Council.

The number two candidate on the Li ticket is Ian Harrold who has lived in Ryde for over 40 years and has three children.

"He has been an active community volunteer with the Gladesville Uniting Church, Lions, Rotary and is a director of Life Education devoting his time to teach local kids to say no to alcohol and other drugs," Mr Li said.

"Our number three ticket presents Patricia Gil-

christ who has lived in Danstone with her husband John for over 16 years," he said.

"Patricia has a background in urban planning and is passionate about architecture, regional and community arts, as well as children and youth mentoring.

"A dedicated volunteer, she is secretary of the Eastwood Croquet Club."

Completing the Li team is Dr Yvonne Wang. "Dr Wang is a resident of North Ryde and a local GP in multicultural Eastwood, with an unusual background of having lived in five different

countries by the time she was 18," Mr Li said.

"She actively serves in the 1503 Bread of Life Christian Church, which runs one of its Sunday services in the West Ryde Community Centre."

Mr Li also paid tribute to his team of volunteer campaigners and his right-hand man, Mr Choo.

"Choo knows just about every family living in Eastwood and just about every family knows him," Mr Li said.

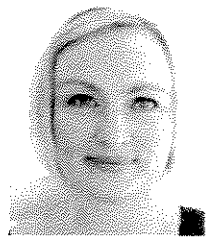

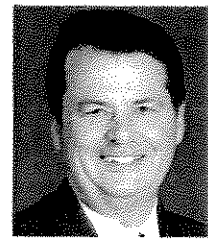
