Selection criteria	Weighting of selection criteria in relation to each other
1. Significant experience investigating alleged serious offences and/or public sector misconduct.	35%
2. A good knowledge of the criminal law, the rules of evidence and criminal procedures, an understanding of the <i>Independent Commission Against Corruption Act 1988</i> , the machinery of government and public sector organisational systems.	25%
3. Well-developed planning and organisational abilities, problem solving and analytical skills.	20%
4. Be able to write well and communicate effectively with people of diverse background, occupation, and seniority, both internal and external to the Commission.	20%
