SELECTION CRITERIA

MANDATORY PROFESSIONAL QUALIFICATION	
A law degree and admitted or eligible for admission as a barrister or solicitor of the Supreme Court of New South Wales.	
SELECTION CRITERIA	Weighting of selection criteria in relation to each other
Sound legal knowledge and experience, particularly in criminal law and/or administrative law and a sound knowledge of the rules of evidence, procedural fairness and the ICAC Act.	25%
Demonstrated analytical, organisational, and oral written communication skills.	25%
Demonstrated ability to organise hearings including instructing counsel and appearing as counsel in compulsory examinations.	20%
Mature judgement, tenacity and ability to work in a multi-disciplinary team and the ability to protect sensitive information.	20%
Commitment to ethical public sector administration and the Commission	10%
