A law degree and admitted or eligible for admission as a barrister or solicitor of the Supreme Court of New South Wales.	
SELECTION CRITERIA	Weighting of selection criteria in relation to each other
Extensive Legal knowledge and experience, particularly in criminal law and administrative law and a sound knowledge of the rules of evidence, procedural fairness and the ICAC Act.	25%
High level analytical, organisational and oral and written communication skills.	25%
Demonstrated ability to plan for and organise hearings, including instructing counsel and appearing as counsel.	15%
Mature judgement, tenacity and ability to work in a multi-disciplinary team and the ability to protect sensitive information.	15%
The ability to provide leadership and a high level of motivation.	10%
Commitment to ethical public sector administration and the Commission's purpose.	10%
