Further to Arthur Spellson's email. You may be aware that China is currently the biggest market for Australian raw cotton. In 2011 62% of our product was exported to China.

We receive daily enquiries from China regarding the purchase of Australian cotton and I believe a number of Chinese delegations have visited Australia this year. I would suggest that those buyers make direct contact with ACSA members. A list and relevant contact information can be found at our website www.austcottonshippers.com.au.

Please be aware that merchants may refer potential buyers to their China-based agents. Some may conduct business directly with spinning mills and others will have agency arrangements in place.
