And how long have you been the managing director of United World Enterprises?---Since 1993.

And do you currently have any other occupation?---I still have some director with another company.

And what's the other company?--- Currabubula Station and also oaten hay, Riverina Hay.

And are all of those businesses connected to United World Enterprises?

---Separate is, Riverina Hay separate and Currabubula Station connect to United World Enterprises, which is a United World Enterprise investor.

So Currabubula Station invests in United World Enterprises. Is that correct? ---Yeah, UWE Currabubula Station Pty Ltd.

And what business does United World Enterprises conduct generally?---Import/export.

And has it been doing that since 2013 at least?---Since 1993 we start it and


And what are you responsibilities as the managing director of UWE? --- Day by day running.

Yeah.---Operate the company sales.

And have you been doing that since 1993?---Sorry?

Have you been managing the day-to-day operations of United World Enterprises since 1993?---Yes.





Now, you also mentioned a company called Riverina Hay. What is Riverina Hay?---Riverina Hay is a producer oaten hay for dairy farm. We export to China and Korea. This location is Leeton.

And that's Leeton in New South Wales?---Yes.

How long has Riverina Hay been operating out of Leeton?---1995. Sorry, 2005.

2005. And was it known as Riverina Hay?---2015, yeah, 2015.

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All right.---Yeah.

So Riverina Hay has been operating in the Leeton area since 2015. Is that correct?---Yes, yes. A joint venture used to is a JV with a China Government company, Shanghai.

What's the name of the Chinese Government company?---Called Bright Food.

40 Bright Food.---Yeah.

And was Bright Food involved in the joint venture to establish the hay business in 2015?---Yes.

So from the beginning?---From beginning China Government own 51 per cent, UWE 49 per cent.
