ROBERTS: - got a particular, you know companies in mind.

MAGUIRE: Yeah.

ROBERTS: 'Cause it's easier for us to talk to or contact you know, three or four companies that are likely to be interested rather than go out to the 200 membership (laughs) and, and -

MAGUIRE: Yes correct, that's - you're, you're exactly on, on message. Um what I, what I suggested was look, um, give us a brief of the technology, that we basically share that with you and -

ROBERTS: Yep.

MAGUIRE: - limit, limit it to two approaches, only two companies because they, they want someone with an excess of um, dormant wells and I would've thought that would, one of those would've been Santos, um would probably have the most oil and gas.

ROBERTS: Oh I, I was thinking that it - I'm assuming this um, ah essentially this is for onshore gas and so if you're looking at Santos, maybe Beach, um, so the operators in the Cooper Basin if you like -

MAGUIRE: Yep.

ROBERTS: - and um, you know there might be, there might be one or two other parties that'd be interested. And again, it sort of determin - ah, depends upon at what stage in the cycle, the well, are they interested. Or, or is their technology applicable because um, you know plugged and abandoned wells are the sort of wells that um, would be fairly expensive to, to start again. Um, you know you've actually filled them -

MAGUIRE: Mmm.

MAGUIRE: Yeah, yeah I, I – I, you know, they were talking about going to the conference, there's no point because all your doing is shopping blind. You need to talk to you know, the head of the organisation, get some guidance and you know, do it professionally otherwise it's, it's you know, you're wasting a lot of time.

ROBERTS: Well that's true and, and one of the things that might make it a little bit easier for us and for them, is that um, you know more and more we're a gas industry rather than an oil and gas industry.
